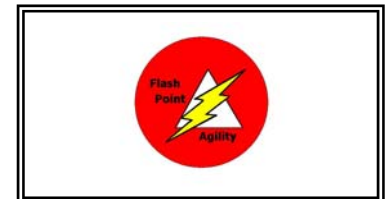

Dogs requiring measuring must be measured prior to being checked in. A dog that is measured up, but unprepared to jump the higher height may run For Exhibition Only, but no awards or qualifying scores may be earned and no change in program is permitted at check-in.

Every competitor must present their temporary or permanent height cards or USDAA-issued letter at check-in. **YOU MAY SEND A COPY OF YOUR PERMENANT(YELLOW) CARD WITH YOUR ENTRY to AVOID LINES FOR CHECK IN.** Set up is permitted from 4 PM till 7pm Fri night. The

A registration number with the "J" prefix will be assigned for use in entering UJHP events. A Dog that is expected to compete in both programs (regular classes and UJHP) must be registered separately for each program. Take Ohio Interstate I-71 to Exit 140 (Rte 61)

Turn on Rte 61 North (towards Mt Gilead) for 2 miles to traffic light

Turn left (west) on Rt. 229 for 4 miles to first Road (Twp 166) that goes right only (no road sign for 166, but Flash Point sign on left of 229).

Twp 166 is just before Munday's yellow sign on right.

Twp 166 is just after Clear Run lumber company on left (no joke!).

Twp 166 is before self storage on left and before RR tracks.

Turn right on TWP Rd 166 for 0.4 miles to Blue house on left 1580.

Sign on left.

NOTICE TO COMPETITORS

Competitors through submission of entry acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of USDAA® rules and regulations as amended March 30, 2007 which are hereby incorporated by reference. A copy of USDAA®'s official rules may be viewed online at www.usdaa.com.

This test is open to all dogs being at least eighteen (18) months of age, including purebred and non-purebred, except bitches in season, dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness that may affect the dog's physical or mental performance, or dogs exhibiting sign of aggression.

All dogs must be registered with USDAA® in order to compete. Register online for a reduced fee at www.usdaa.com, click on General Information/Dog Registration to receive a registration number immediately and a height card prior to the match. Registration may be made concurrently with entry to this match, a form for which is included in this Agility Test Schedule.

The Organizing Committee of an event may refuse the entry of any competitor or dog for just cause should the committee views that participation by competitor or dog would be prejudicial to the sport. However, any committee so doing must notify the competitor in writing (with a copy to the USDAA office) in anticipation of or upon receipt of entry. The notice must include the reason for refusing the entry and a brief explanation of the basis for their decision. The burden of responsibility for appropriateness of such action rests solely with the host group and its Organizing Committee.

All competitors through entry at this event waive any and all rights relative to video broadcast of this event. Competitors shall have the right to videotape portions of this event for their personal use only. No portion of this event may be videotaped for commercial or other purposes. All video, broadcast and telecast rights for this event are the exclusive property of United States Dog Agility Association®, Inc.

Portions of this event may be taped for television. Through entry at this event, ALL COMPETITORS and HANDLERS HEREBY GRANT to USDAA® and its representatives, agents and assigns, all rights and permission to use or appropriate his/her and their dog's name, biography, likeness, photograph, voice, performing persona, or other indicia of identity for broadcast, telecast, cablecast, transmission or distribution in any format or media now known. All competitors and handlers hereby release USDAA® and its representatives, agents and assigns from any claim or cause of action for invasion of the rights of privacy, right of publicity, right of personality, or any similar right.

Fault Limits may be imposed by the Organizing Committee and/or judge and will be announced in the judge's briefing

Agility obstacles shall meet the requirements of USDAA® rules and regulations. There will be no equipment familiarization on the day of the test. A small warm-up area and a single practice jump will be provided for dogs entered in the show. No other equipment or training devices will be allowed on the show grounds the day of the test.

- ★ No leads, collars, food, toys or other aids or devices shall be permitted on the course at any time.

Following are the jump heights for the Championship Program (Performance heights in parenthesis):

- ★ **The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this test, competitors acknowledge that they are familiar with and able to perform obstacles safely.**
- ★ To be accepted, entries must be complete, *signed* (by parent or legal guardian if handler is a minor), received no later than Sat, May 10, 2008 and accompanied by the correct fees (**payable to Flash Point Agility** in U.S. Funds only). Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, and no entry shall be refunded in event of such errors, or cancellation of such entries after the closing date. **Please type or print carefully the information on the entry forms to eliminate errors.** If entry is sent overnight, please waive the signature requirement.
- ★ **Entry Fee Policy:** Declined payments (i.e. "insufficient funds" and/or otherwise a "bad check") that come to our attention following the closing date but prior to the event must be paid in full before the event begins. Failure to do so will automatically result in loss of right to show at the event. Where declined payments come to our attention following the event, entry fees and/or registrations must be paid in full, including any NSF charges, and must be received by the match secretary within 30 days following the event date or the receipt of notice of declined payment, whichever is later. Payment shall be in the form of cash, money order or cashiers check. **Failure to settle delinquent payments shall result in automatic cancellation of event results,** and all prizes and awards shall be returned for distribution to the valid winners or registration numbers will

be suspended from further competition until such time as any awards are returned. Under no circumstances shall the "canceled results" be reinstated. This is a USDAA® policy.

- ★ **No refunds will be issued for amounts under \$10.00**
- ★ ***There shall be no refunds*** for entries withdrawn after the closing date except as described below, or in the event that a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition, regardless of reason for such dismissal. In addition, no entry fee will be refunded if the match cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, and act of God (including weather that the Organizing Committee in its sole determination shall deem unsafe), public emergency, act of a public enemy, strike, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizers.
- ★ A withdrawal after the closing date due to injury of the dog/handler, illness OF THE DOG or for bitches that come into season after the closing date will be eligible for a refund minus USDAA fees plus a service fee of \$5 if supported by a written notice from a veterinarian. In such instances the secretary **MUST** be notified receive supporting documentation received by July 14. Any other withdrawals after the closing date will not be eligible for refund.
- ★ Any competitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Organizing Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any entry fee will be made.

CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

Two certification programs will be offered at this event - Championship & Performance. Competitors may enter both Championship and Performance Program classes for which they are eligible; however, **under NO circumstance may a dog be entered in the same Championship and Performance class at this agility test** (i.e. standard at any level in both programs). Classes include standard agility, gamblers, jumpers, pairs relay and snooker agility as set forth in Chapters 3 - 7 of USDAA Rules and Regulations, each of which are conducted at three competitive levels

CHAMPIONSHIP PROGRAM CLASSES

The Starters Standard classes shall be for dogs that have not earned the *Agility Dog*® title or a Starters Standard title. Starters Non-standard classes shall be for dogs that have not earned a title in the class being entered (Starters Gamblers, Starters Jumpers, Starters Relay-3 different partners required-or Starters Snooker) or a qualifying score in the equivalent non-standard class at the Advanced or Masters level. When offered separately as Starters and Novice classes, the Starters level classes are for dogs handled by a person who has not previously earned the *Agility Dog* title or a title in the Performance or Veterans Program with any dog. Three qualifying scores in the standard class from two different judges along with one qualifying score in each of the nonstandard classes is required to earn the *Agility Dog* title.

The Advanced Standard classes shall be for dogs that have earned the *Agility Dog*® title or a Starters Standard title. Advanced non-standard classes shall be for dogs that have earned the *Agility Dog*® title or that have earned a title in the equivalent non-standard class at the Starters level, but have not earned the equivalent Advanced non-standard title or a qualifying score in the equivalent non-standard class at the Masters level. Three qualifying scores in the standard class from two different judges along with one qualifying score in each of the nonstandard classes is required to earn the *Advanced Agility Dog* title.

The Masters Standard classes shall be for dogs that have earned the Advanced *Agility Dog*® title or the Advanced Standard title. Masters non-standard classes shall be for dogs that have earned the Advanced *Agility Dog*® title, the equivalent non-standard title at the Advanced level, or that had previously qualified for entry into the equivalent Masters non-standard class prior to January 1, 2004

PERFORMANCE PROGRAM CLASSES:

Generally, Performance Level I, Level II and Level III are run on courses used for Starters, Advanced and Masters classes in the Championship Program, with the following exceptions: the A-frame is set at 5'6", jump heights are one height class lower as set forth in Notes to Competitors, no spread hurdles are utilized and time standards in the standard, jumpers classes are extended by 3 seconds beyond that utilized in the Championship Program. Eligibility is determined as follows:

The Performance I Standard classes shall be for any dog that has not earned the Performance Dog ISM title, the Performance Standard I title, or a qualifying score in the Performance II or Performance III standard classes. Performance I non-standard classes shall be for any dog that has not earned a title in the class being entered (Performance I Gamblers, Performance I Jumpers, or Performance I Snooker) or a qualifying score in the equivalent non-standard class at the Performance II or Performance III level. Three qualifying scores in the standard class from two different judges along with one qualifying score in each of the non-standard classes is required to earn the Performance Dog ISM title

The Performance II Standard classes shall be for any dog that has earned the Performance Dog ISM title, the Performance Standard I title, the *Agility Dog*® title or the Veteran *Agility Dog*SM title, but has not earned the Performance Dog IISM title or Performance Standard II title, or a qualifying score in the Performance III standard class. Performance II non-standard classes shall be for dogs having earned the Performance Dog ISM title, the *Agility Dog*® title or a title in the equivalent Starters or Performance I non-standard class, but not having earned a title in the equivalent non-standard Performance II class or a qualifying score in the equivalent non-standard Performance III class. Three qualifying scores in the standard class from two different judges along with one qualifying score in each of the nonstandard classes is required to earn the Performance Dog IISM title.

The Performance III Standard classes shall be for any dog that has earned the Performance Dog IISM title, the Performance Standard II title, the Advanced *Agility Dog*SM title, or the Veteran Advanced *Agility Dog*SM title. Performance III non-standard classes shall be for dogs having earned the Performance Dog IISM title, the Advanced *Agility Dog*® title, the equivalent non-standard title at the Advanced or Performance II level, or that had previously qualified for entry into the equivalent Performance non-standard class prior to January 1, 2004.

Non-standard Class Descriptions:

These classes are scored pursuant to the provisions of Chapters 6 & 7 of the USDAA Rules & Regulations

Gamblers Class: consists of a course with no pre-determined route and each obstacle is assigned a point value. In the 'opening' period the handler seeks to accumulate points by performing the obstacles of his / her choice in the time allotted. At the conclusion of the 'opening' the handler attempts the 'gamble', as a sequence designated by the judge to be handled from a distance, for additional points.

Jumpers Class: consists of a course of jumps and may include a tire and tunnels.

Snooker Class: has an 'opening' sequence of point collection similar to the Gamblers followed by a closing sequence of a set pattern. Roughly parallels the billiards game of 'Snooker', requiring the dog to successfully complete a 'red' jump prior to attempting an obstacle designated as any other color.

Pairs Relay: consists of a standard course with one dog and handler running a portion of the course, followed by a baton exchange to a second handler and dog who run the second portion of the course. Partners must be in the same level and same height division, mini or open. In the event only one dog is entered in the program/level, un-entered dogs or dogs from other programs may NOT be recruited to form a qualifying pair.

Any additional rules will be described by the judge during the briefing. Dogs can be paired in either of the two divisions (Mini or Open) as defined as follows:

MINI	OPEN
8" - Performance	16" - Performance
12"-Performance	22" - Performance
12"- Championship	22" - Championship
16"- Championship	26" - Championship

Grand Prix of Dog Agility® World Championships & Performance National

StandardSM Championships Local Qualifiers: These single-round tournaments are open to all dogs regardless of skill level or titles earned and are judged under Masters rules. Competitors earning five (5) or fewer faults shall earn a qualifying score. The first place dog/handler in each jump height earning a qualifying score will be awarded a 'bye' in the final round of a Regional Championship. One qualifying score is required to enter Round 1 of a Regional Championship and two (2) qualifying scores are required to enter the quarterfinals at the world championships.
